Location: Lowell's Boat Shop-Essex
Shipbuilding Museum (*Merrimack, Plum
Island, Parker, Ipswich, and Essex Rivers*)

Have your child learn to row a traditional dory while exploring the backwaters of the Great Marsh between Newburyport and Essex. Under the direction of experienced and certified instructors, your son/daughter will be taught traditional rowing commands, basic marine safety, basic navigation, teamwork, and will learn how to plan a trip on the water and appreciate the surrounding nature and wildlife. The five-day expedition begins at Lowell's Boat Shop in Amesbury and winds through the marshes, finally ending up at the Essex Shipbuilding Museum in Essex on the fifth day. The expedition will take place daily for one week from 8 am to 4 pm. Adventurers will be bused daily from Lowell's Boat Shop to the boats and back again.
